- Ideas For Literacy - (Mum / Dad - you may need to get an extra copy)
  - Pick a sheet that your teacher gave you in Gaeilge or English or do a page from handwriting book go onto next list in Gaeilge spellings
  - Infants - revise all sounds & words, make simple words using sound cards, the jolly phonics app, colouring and letter writing
  - 5 Sentences using your spelling lists
  - Write 10 interesting facts about: Favourite Country/Sport/ favourite Animal/Human body - Heart, lungs, skin, muscles, hair, Covid-19
  - Keep a Diary - don't forget to date it!
  - Write a story about your favourite memory
  - Reading - try reading buddies with your family!!
  - Write an email/letter to your teacher/principal/friend
  - Make a Boggle Board and see how many word you can make
  
- Ideas for Numeracy (Mum / Dad - you may need to get an extra copy)
  - An activity from a sheet your teacher gave you. (Remember your tables)
  - Skip counting - in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, 10s and 20s. Then try 6s.7s.8s. & 9s!!
  - Count the money in your money box / wallet!! - (if allowed)
  - What time / Month/ Season/day is it? - write answers in your copy
  - Do a day out of Master your Maths - 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> class
  - Make up maths problems and solve them. Make A NOGGLE Board!!
  - Play snakes and ladders
  - Roll a dice and add numbers together / multiply numbers
  - 2d shape treasure hunt!! List all the 2d shapes in your kitchen/sitting room/garden etc!!
  - Length - measure the length of the furniture in your bedroom
  - Weight - bake a cake and write out the recipe measurements.
