School Self Evaluation - As part of our schools SSE this year our focus will be on Wellbeing, Oral Language and IT. Thanks very much for completing the recent surveys.

AR is designed to establish a culture of reading in children through giving them autonomy over what they choose to read. It also allows us to monitor children's progress and provide feedback when required. On Fridays during our Power Hour Session the pupils share their opinions, likes/dislikes and book reports with their friends and teachers. We have been reading so many books and

there is great excitement about the Word Count Leader Boards in each class. Well done everyone and keep up the great reading.
